**II. DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON REGULATORY MATTERS.**

**A. J. David Brown - investigative interview 2:15 pm**

Dr. Brown was present with Brenda Maloney and Hector Diaz of Quarles & Brady Attorneys at Law for the investigation interview.

The Board asked questions of Dr. Brown to which he responded. Following discussion, the Board tabled the investigative interview, and requested the following:

1. Subpoena Dr. Brown's complete medical records for patient S. W.
2. Subpoena Dr. Brown's complete medical records for Patients D.M and E.M.
3. Subpoena Dr. Mary Peter's complete medical records on her treatment of Dr. Brown
4. Subpoena Dr. Odel's complete medical records on Dr. Brown.

**MOTION:** Dr. Kaplan moved to go into executive session to obtain confidential legal advice. Ms. Reagan seconded the motion.

The Board convened Executive Session to obtain legal advice at 3:24 pm  
The Board returned to Regular Session at 3:43 pm

The Board also ordered Dr. Brown to submit to a drug urinalysis, hair analysis and blood test immediately following the board meeting, with the results to be submitted directly to the Board upon completion. Dr. Brown is also to undergo a comical evaluation for Addictionologist at a Board appointed Psychiatric doctor. Dr. Brown is to cover all cost for this evaluation and the results are to be sent directly

**MOTION:** Dr. Kaplan moved to have Dr. Brown undergo an independent psychiatric evaluation within fifteen day's from receipt of a board letter. That will have names of doctors to contact with instructions to have the evaluation within forty-five days and the report to be received by the Board thirty days after the evaluation has been done. Receive the drug/alcohol test and to continue the Investigative Interview to receive the requested evaluation(s) and drug tests, Dr. Polakof seconded the motion.

**B. George Thompson**

The Board discussed the issue with obtaining a doctor to do the psychiatric evaluation on Dr. Thompson. The Board directed staff to contact other doctors on the list and find one who will do the evaluation.
