One or more members of the Board may participate in the meeting by telephonic communications.

The meeting is open to the public. In addition, the Board may vote to go into Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2) as indicated on the Agenda for the purpose of considering or reviewing records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law. The executive session is not open to the public.
