8 At its meeting on September 9, 2020, the Arizona State Board of Podiatry
9 Examiners (Board) voted to issue Katherine Kennedy, DPM (Respondent), a non-
10 disciplinary Continuing Education (CE) Order as a result of the documentation concerns
11 raised in the complaint. The Board, pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-852.01(C)(3), determined
12 that while the conduct was not of sufficient seriousness to merit direct action against
13 Respondent, she would, as set forth below, benefit from completing a prescribed number
14 of hours of continuing education in a specific practice area for purposes of providing her
15 with the necessary understanding of current developments, skills, procedures or treatment.

16 **ORDER**

17 1. **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that within six months from the effective date
18 of this Order, Respondent shall complete a minimum of six hours of Board approved CE.
19 Three hours must be in the area of recognizing post-operative complications of surgical
20 procedures at the 5th MPJ. The other three hours must be in the area of radiological review.
21 The CE hours shall be in addition to the hours required for the annual renewal of her
22 podiatry license, and can be completed online.

23 2. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Respondent shall, within six months of
24 the effective date of this Order, provide Board staff with proof of attendance in satisfaction
25 of this requirement.

1 3. Respondent's failure to timely comply with the Order will subject her to
2 future disciplinary action by the Board. A.R.S. § 32-854.01(21).

3 4. The effective date of the Order is the date it is signed by the Board's
4 Executive Director.

5 RIGHT TO APPEAL

6 **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.03(B), you
7 may request a formal hearing by notifying the Board in writing within thirty-five (35)
8 days from date of this Order. If you request a formal hearing, you also have the right to
9 request an informal settlement conference by filing a written request with the Board,
10 pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.06, no later than twenty (20) days before the scheduled
11 hearing. The conference will be held within fifteen (15) days after receipt of your
12 request. Please note that you waive any right to object to the participation of the Board's
13 representative in the final administrative decision of the matter if it is not settled at the
14 conference.
