**NOTICE OF MEETING**  
OF THE ARIZONA STATE BOARD OF PODIATRY EXAMINERS

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute (“A.R.S”) § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona State Board of Podiatry Examiners (“Board”) and to the general public that the Board will hold a meeting open to the public on **Wednesday, June 13, 2018 at 8:30 a.m.** The meeting will be held in Board Room C located at 1740 West Adams Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. One or more members of the Board may participate in the meeting by telephonic communications.

The meeting is open to the public. However, the Board may vote to go into Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) for any matter listed on the Agenda in order to obtain legal advice from counsel. In addition, the Board may vote to go into Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2) as indicated on the Agenda for the purpose of considering or reviewing records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law. The executive session is not open to the public.

Information concerning the Board’s Agenda, including a copy of the Agenda and any amendments, can be obtained at the Board’s office, through the Board’s website at <https://podiatry.az.gov/>, or by calling the Board’s office at 602.542.8151. The Agenda is subject to change up to 24 hours prior to the meeting. Agenda items are noted by number and letter for convenience and reference. **VII. REVIEW, DISCUSSION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR PERFORMANCE REVIEW**

Upon a vote of the majority of a quorum, the Board may go into executive session, pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(1) for discussion or consideration of employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, dismissal, salaries, disciplining or resignation of a public officer, appointee or employee of any public body, except that, with the exception of salary discussions, an officer, appointee or employee may demand that the discussion or consideration occur at a public meeting.

**VIII. SUMMARY OF CURRENT EVENTS**

By law, the summary of current events is limited to summarizing recent occurrences. The Board cannot propose, discuss, deliberate or take legal action on any matter in the summary unless the specific matter is properly noticed for legal action.

**IX. CALL TO THE PUBLIC**

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.01(H), the Board may make an open call to the public during a public meeting, subject to reasonable time, place and manner restrictions, to allow individuals to address the public body on any issue within the jurisdiction of the public body. However, members of the Board are not allowed to discuss or take legal action on matters raised during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action. The Board, however, may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda.
