

TEMPORARY APPLICATION

1. Does Arizona have a temporary license?

Yes, Arizona has a temporary license. In order to qualify for a temporary license an applicant must hold an active and unrestricted independent license in podiatric medicine in a State, Territory or Possession of the United States. All license verifications must be submitted directly to the Board office. The license is a 30-day license and is non-renewable. 2. What is the fee for the temporary license/application?

The fee for a temporary license/application is \$100.00.
