

1 3. Dr. Wessel agrees that the Board may adopt this Addendum or any part of this
2 agreement under A.R.S. §§ 32-852 and 32-852.01. Dr. Wessel understands that the Board may
3 consider this Addendum or any part of it in any future disciplinary action against him.

4 4. The Addendum shall be subject to adoption by the Board and shall be effective
5 only when signed by the President of the Board, or the Executive Director of the Board, on behalf
6 of the President.

7 5. Dr. Wessel understands that this Addendum is a public record that may be publicly
8 disseminated as a formal action of the Board and may be reported to the National Practitioner Data
9 Bank, in accordance with federal regulations.

10 6. Dr. Wessel understands that any violation of this Addendum could be grounds for
11 further disciplinary action by the Board pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-854.01(21).

17 **AMENDMENT TO ORDER**

18 As of the effective date of this Addendum, the Order contained on page 5 of the Consent
19 Agreement is amended to read as follows:

20 Dr. Wessel shall not practice (1) Podiatry or (2) provide direct patient care as a Surgical
21 Tech or Medical Assistant for a Podiatrist in the State of Arizona until such time that Dr. Wessel
22 fulfills the terms of the Consent Agreement for Suspension in case 17-07-B and appears before
23 the Board and the Board votes to restore his practice privileges.

24 If Dr. Wessel obtains employment as a Surgical Tech or Medical Assistant for a non-
25 Podiatrist, Dr. Wessel shall immediately inform the Board. Dr. Wessel shall ensure that his
26 supervising physician submits quarterly reports detailing Dr. Wessel's work performance to the

1 Board. The reports shall be due according to the schedule set by the Executive Director of the
2 Board once employment is reported.

3 If Dr. Wessel seeks employment as a Medical Assistant for a non-Podiatrist, Dr. Wessel
4 is responsible for knowing and abiding by all statutes and rules applicable to the practice of
5 Medical Assistants, if any, by the relevant governing Board.

6 **All other provisions of the Consent Agreement remain in full force and effect.**
