**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING OF THE

IN VIOLATION OF OPEN MEETING LAW**

Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.05, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona Board of Podiatry Examiners, ("Board"), and to the general public that the Board will hold a meeting open to the public on April 9, 2014 at 8:30 a.m. at 1400 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, in basement conference room B-1. The purpose of the meeting is to ratify an action of the Board that may have been taken in violation of the Open Meeting Law. This action involved the following:

On February 12, 2014 the Board reviewed information submitted by its licensee Kelvin Crezee, DPM, in relation to a consent agreement and order issued in complaint investigation case number 11-09-M. At that time the Board members voted to open a new complaint case with the allegation that Dr. Crezee violated the terms of the consent agreement. It was later learned that, prior to the review and vote on February 12, Board Member Dr. Joseph Leonetti had a telephone discussion with Dr. Crezee regarding the completion of the consent agreement order terms.

The public may obtain a detailed written description of the action to be ratified, and all deliberations, consultations, and decisions by members of the Board that preceded and relate to this action to be ratified, at least 72 hours in advance of the meeting at the following location(s): 1400 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, in suite #230, on public bulletin boards located in the main lobby and on the second floor, and on the Board's public website at [www.podiatry.az.gov](http://www.podiatry.az.gov).

The Board, upon a majority vote of a quorum of the members, may hold an *Executive Session* on any of the listed agenda items, **I through X**, to discuss or consider records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law, or to obtain legal advice. A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A) (2) and (3). Those wishing to address the Board do not need to request permission in advance; however, the Board may limit those persons speaking during the "Call to the Public" at three (3) per side on any one issue. A.R.S. § 38-431.01(G). The Board can only take action on matters listed on the agenda and other matters related thereto. A.R.S. § 38-431.02(H). If appropriate, actions on public comment matters that are not listed on the agenda will be limited to directing staff to study the matter or schedule the matter for further discussion at a later date. A.R.S. § 38-431.01(H).

The Board reserves the right to change the order of items on the agenda, except for matters set for a specific time. The President of the Board reserves the right to call cases in random order. Please note that the recommendations listed on the agenda are merely suggested Board actions. These recommendations do not become final until adopted by the Board. The Board has the authority to accept, reject or modify any recommendation listed in the agenda.
